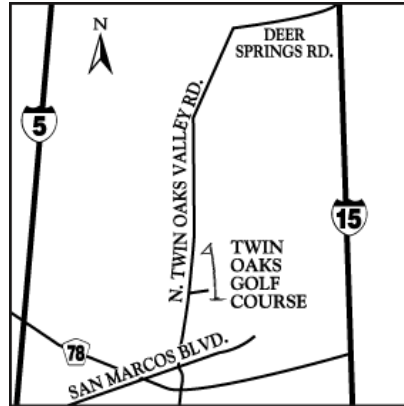

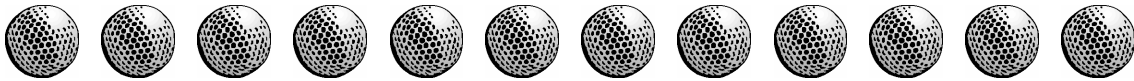
ACI ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT MONDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2011 – TWIN OAKS GOLF COURSE
